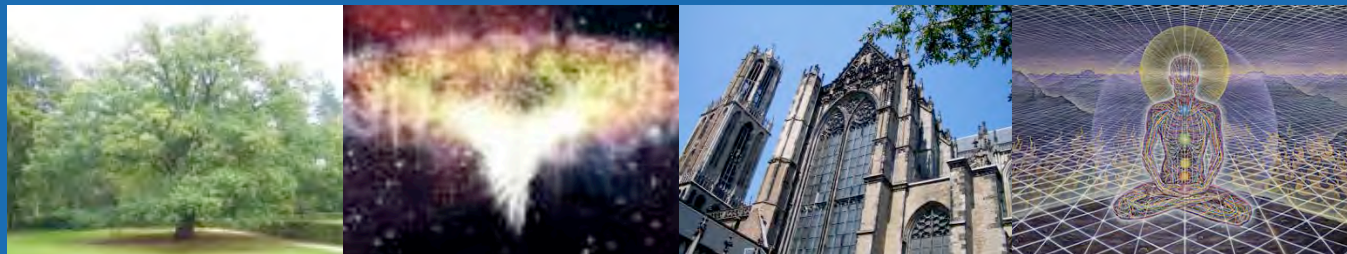


# GEOMANCY



DISCOVERING THE ENERGETIC LANDSCAPE OF THE NETHERLANDS  
with Richard Leviton

May 16-18 2008, Hoge Veluwe, Otterlo, Netherlands

Join Richard Leviton and a group of up to 20 people to learn the art and science of geomancy. Learning by doing, we will practice on ourselves and the Netherlands by identifying, visiting and interacting with key energetic nodes.

The workshop combines an introduction to the language and practices of geomantic interaction with the local landscape and planet as a whole, identifying some key features in the Dutch landscape that are part of the Dutch "geomythic body" or what could be called Netherlands' sacred landscape. It's sacred because our interaction with it potentially amplifies our awareness and helps us cross the threshold into the spiritual realm of the Earth. The workshop offers conceptual overviews, practical meditative practices that align human awareness with the angelic and elemental (Nature Spirits), and working field trips, where we go out into the landscape to apply these techniques.

The workshop program alternates between explanations and experiences, with lots of time for questions and answers and discussions enriched by field experiences. The workshop will be tailored to the location, situated near some key Dutch geomantic sites. Other sites will also be discussed as we learn how they function as part of a national geomantic body.

The workshop answers the question: how can I help the Earth, how can I relate to it? It provides a geomantic model for "plug-in points" for helping the Earth through local

landscapes and practical, effective, and empirically proven techniques for doing this. Typically, participants experience a wide range of visionary experiences and validations for this approach, completing the workshop empowered with information and tools.

## Richard Leviton



Richard Leviton is a trained clairvoyant, professional book editor, former national health magazine editor, published journalist-author

for 30+ years, and author of 20 books in the fields of world myth, spirituality, landscape mysteries, healing, and natural medicine. He has published 400+ feature magazine articles on these topics. He lives in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Leviton has conducted many workshops, tours, and experiential field trips to do with sacred sites as a foundation for illumination and initiation in the U.S. and England. He has been studying and researching Earth energies, geomancy, visionary geography, and the Mysteries since 1984 inaugurated during a 2 1/2 year immersion study in England.



## What is Geomancy?

The Earth is covered in thousands of holy places, sacred sites, and pilgrimage destinations. We now know where many of these once venerated and still numinous locations are, but why are they holy and sacred and the focus of so many pilgrimages? What makes them that way? Are they all the same? What role do they play in the Earth's overall life? What are the most effective ways to interact with them? These are some of the many vital questions about Earth Mysteries we will be exploring.

Sacred sites, holy places, and pilgrimage locations are part of the focus of a discipline known as geomancy. This means the divination (*mantos*) of the energy and consciousness secrets of the Earth (*Ge*). Think of Earth Mysteries as the natural extension of the famous Gaia Hypothesis. Sacred sites and holy places function within the Earth's geomantic terrain, an interconnected planetary system that supports higher consciousness in humans through connecting them with the galaxy and spiritual worlds through apertures across the Earth's surface at sacred sites. This terrain is also called the Earth's visionary geography, because it is a landscape that inspires visions into its nature, which is a template of the cosmos.

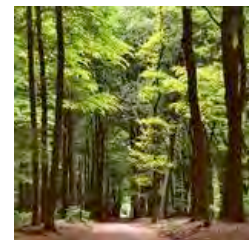
Situated right next to the entrance to the national park Hoge Veluwe, the hotel is ideally placed for us to make the best use of the powerful natural environment nearby.
